FORT SMITH, ARKANSAS, THAT:





SUBJECT: Purchase of Cranes
DATE: September 11, 2018

Bids were solicited for the purchase a 22 ton mid-mounted hydraulic crane truck and a 40 ton rear-mounted hydraulic crane & truck for use by the Fleet Building and Environmental Maintenance Division of the City of Fort Smith Utility Department.

The lowest and acceptable bid received for the 22 ton truck was from Shipley Motor Equipment in the amount of \$245,225.44 and the lowest and acceptable bid for the 40 ton truck was from Doggett Freightliner in the amount of \$344,626.23.

Funding for these cranes have been appropriated for in the 2018 Budget Capital Outlay-Other Equipment account (56260000-531600). Also, as noted in the attached memorandum from Mr. Lance McAvoy, one of these cranes (Asset 892) is a replacement of a 2014 International 7400 Maxforce Manitex crane truck that was damaged in July of 2017 and declared a total loss.

I recommend that the bids noted by enclosure on the attached bid tabulation be accepted.

Subject: Purchase of Cranes

Two cranes were requested for purchase by the Building, Station, and Easement Maintenance Program (Program 5626). One was approved in the 2018 budget and the other was to replace the crane that was damaged in July 2017 and insurance declared it a total loss.

Specifications were provided for the new 22-ton mid-mounted crane and the replacement for the 40-ton rear-mounted crane. Although the truck system was not specified in the bid specifications, the cranes were. Both cranes were to be of the same manufacturer to allow consistency of safety equipment and to enable similar control layout for operator use.

Having reviewed the bid sheets, staff recommends Doggett Freightliner in Van Buren as the vendor of choice for the 40-ton crane, and Shipley Motor Equipment of Fort Smith as the vendor of choice for the 22-ton crane. This is based on both the fleet maintenance staff recommendation on easy of repair and reliability of the truck, and the overall price of the crane assembly.

Funds for the 22-ton crane are in 56260000-531600. It is understood an ordinance for the transfer of funds from the insurance settlement will be also placed in 56260000-531600 for the purchase of the 40-ton crane.
