### **MINUTES**

The Fort Smith Port Authority scheduled a regular meeting at 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, April 20, 2023 at the Port of Fort Smith, 200 Navy Road, Fort Smith.

After a box lunch provided by Bank OZK and arranged by Philip Doss, the meeting was called to order by chairman Larry Combs at 11:53 a.m. and a quorum was noted present. Other Port Authority members present were Philip Doss, Eddie Norman and Chad Lane. Dustin Collyge was absent. Others attending included Marty Shell, Cameron Hubbs and Jeff Dingman.

The minutes of the January 26, 2023 regular meeting were presented for approval. Mr. Norman moved approval of the minutes. Mr. Doss seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous vote.

The Port Authority reviewed the Port Authority's bank account statements as of March 31, 2023. As of that date, the balance in the grant account stands at \$1.11 and the Port Authority's main operating account as at \$138,477.59. Mr. Doss reported that the combined balance of the three Certificates of Deposit stands at \$2,016,449. One of the three CD's matures September 1, 2023, the other two mature March 1, 2024. It is anticipated that all three will find better interest rates when reinvested. Mr. Lane moved approval of the Treasurer's Report. Mr. Norman seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Shell delivered the Operators Report, stating that the Arkansas Waterways Grant will be back in play for public ports starting next fall, and encouraged applying for funding to help build Warehouse #4, estimated to cost \$1.2 million. The AWC grant requires a 10% match, but the award and benefit could be significant. Mr. Shell will keep the Port Authority apprised of the grant program and schedule when it is released. He has identified an organic soy product customer, and such a customer would need a dedicated warehouse, so Warehouse #4 could serve that purpose. He is also discussing a potential project with Yaffe to connect to the rail spur across Port property. More details on that to come if the project develops.

Mr. Shell reported that in the first quarter 2023 the Port of Fort Smith saw a total of 10,735 net tons of material. The Port of Van Buren handled 54,162 net tons of material. Total for the quarter at both facilities was 64,898 net tons. This is on pace with the previous year, but the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter is expected to slow down. Mr. Shell expects the last two quarters of 2023 should be stronger than the previous year. Mr. Doss asked how it is determined what material goes to each port, and Mr. Shell replied that is largely dependent on which port has available space for a particular product. Currently the Port of Fort Smith warehouses are about 55% full.

Mr. Combs asked for consideration to pay two invoices from FTN Engineers for work done on the no-rise analysis report authorized at the January meeting. Invoice #69837 is for \$1,815 and Invoice #69987 is for \$4,716.25 for a total of \$6,531.25. This amount is below the \$8,500 allocated for the project. Mr. Norman moved to approve payment of the two invoices. Mr. Lane seconded the motion, and the motion was approved by a vote of four in favor, zero opposed.

The Port Authority was provided with and reviewed a copy of the FTN no-rise analysis report. No action was taken.

Mr. Combs asked about the timing of the city's Mill Creek project to improve the drainage channel. Design of the project is underway, it should be bid by this summer. The city has allocated up to \$3 million for this drainage improvement project. It was noted that the railroad bridge still has issues that need to be addressed.

The next regular meeting of the Fort Smith Port Authority is scheduled for Thursday, July 20, 2023. There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:27 pm.
